Please note that the contents of your submission will still be disclosed on request, but the University will first attempt to remove information that reveals your identity. Despite this precaution, in some cases the author may be identified from the contents of the submission.

If there is an application under the *Right to Information Act 2009 / Information Privacy Act 2009*, the success of the University's efforts to argue the case for non-disclosure of the identity will depend on the merits of the individual case and the provisions of the Acts.
